Dear PRA department:

Per California Government Code section 1450 - 1463 ([https://california.public.law/codes/ca\\_gov't\\_code\\_section\\_1450](https://california.public.law/codes/ca_gov't_code_section_1450)), ***bonds are required to be issued on every government employee.***

I do not appreciate these games to evade the CPRA laws. Instead of filling my request in accordance with the CPRA law, you evaded fulfillment by utilizing a deceptive sleight of hand word trick whereby you have conflated two separate issues as if they were one and the same: bonds on attorneys in order to practice law and bonds on government employees in order to work for the government.

***Again, I am asking for a copy of Anna Barsegyan's bond which was issued to her as a State of California employee*** in accordance with the above referenced California Government Code section 1450 - 1463.

I also would like a copy of all pages of the DOJ's manuals which reference the protocols for the issuance and filing of bonds in accordance with California Government Code section 1450 - 1463. There must be some documents in the manuals regarding these requirements.
