Dear Public Servants:

I am requesting an in-person meeting with Mr. Weisz and Ms. Ison to discuss the following issues:

1. As of November 1, 2023, Jason Weisz had never filed an Oath of Office with the Secretary of State as is required by law for his job as a member of Senator Atkins team. I request that Mr. Weisz immediately file an oath or resign from his current position. As an FYI, Mr. Weisz is subject to three years in prison for failing to file an oath with the SOS.
2. As was documented via the *Grab vs. FTB* court case, the Franchise Tax Board has been running multiple fraudulent schemes in order to overcharge lawful taxpayers. Furthermore, as was exposed in 2023, the executive management of FTB that are perpetrating these schemes also do not have properly executed oaths. It is no surprise that people who never promised to uphold the laws of the state and federal constitutions are exploiting the very same people who pay their wages.

The constituents that FTB targets in these schemes are the very same people that Ms. Atkins claims to be protecting: seniors, small business owners, the homeless, etc. I expect the *Speaker Pro Tem* to take action to halt these *bona fide* criminal schemes. I want to schedule a meeting to discuss Ms. Atkins plan to stop the Franchise Tax Board's exploitative schemes.

So again, I request that Mr. Wiener file a current Oath of Office today or that he resign today.
