

Dear Scott Weiner Staff and Senate Committee Staff:

Per the email below from the Secretary of State's Office, Mr. Weiner has *never* filed an Oath of Office with the Secretary of State for any of the terms that he has served as a public servant.

Oaths of Office are required to be filed with the SOS per Government Code sections 1360, 1362-1369 and Section 3 of Article XX of the Constitution of California. Without a fully executed Oath, Mr. Weiner has been working for The State of California unlawfully and is considered *foreign agent posing as a government official*. Under Title 18 U.S.C.A. § 912, this is a felony punishable with up to three years in federal prison.

I request that Mr. Weiner immediately file an oath with the Secretary of State or immediately resign from his current position. I request that proof of filing be provided to me. We the people are holding our government representatives accountable to following the laws.
