Dear Ms. Grab:

This letter responds to your September 19, 2024 and October 29, 2024 email correspondence to various individuals with the office of Senator Scott Wiener, the Senate Committee on Rules, and other public officials. We have construed your email as a request, made pursuant to the Legislative Open Records Act (Gov. Code, § 9070 et seq.), for a copy of Senator Wiener's signed oath of office for his current term of office.

Enclosed is the record responsive to your request. Additionally, we have enclosed a copy of the Senate Daily Journal, dated December 7, 2020, which records the fact that Associate Justice Martin J. Jenkins of the California Supreme Court administered the oath of office to Senator Wiener and other Senators on that date.

The Senate has complied with all of your records requests to date for Senators' and Senate employees' signed oath documents, including prior such requests that you submitted by email or through other electronic methods on or about the following dates: July 18, 2023; August 31, 2023; and September 4, 2023. Accordingly, we respectfully ask that you refrain from contacting Senators and Senate employees regarding any requests for Senate documents or records and instead direct your requests to the Secretary of the Senate or the Senate Committee on Rules, which is the Senate's custodian of legislative records. (Gov. Code, § 9074.)
