Dear Ms. Contreras, Ms. Braverman, Ms. Cervinka, Mr. Nam, Senator McGuire, Lt. Gov. Kounalakis, Mr. Wiener (note I did not address him as Senator since he does not legally hold that title) and Mr. Wiener's staff:

I have started a petition to demand that the State Senate comply with state and federal laws by vacating Wiener from office and voiding all of the work done by Mr. Wiener from 2019 and on, as Mr. Wiener had no legal standing without an oath and District 11 is legally considered vacant. 264 people have signed the petition so far: <https://www.change.org/p/demand-scott-wiener-s-immediate-removal-from-office-for-committing-felony>.

It is unconscionable that the State Senate refuses to comply with the state and federal laws. The State Senate has essentially told the constituents — who are your employers — that the laws don't apply to State Senate staff. The State Senate has deemed itself tyrannical rulers who "make rules for thee but not for me."

"We the people" will not continue to tolerate this blatant disregard for federal and state laws. The State Senate has power because "we the people" gave you that power, and "we the people" can — and will — take that power away if the State Senate continues to abuse it.
