Hello State Senate:

I'd like to remind you all that oaths and bonds are required by both state and federal law. This means that Trump can swoop in and convict each of you who are working unlawfully without oaths and bonds.

Working without an oath is considered to fraudulently posing as a government agent. There is no statute of limitations on fraud. Trump can retroactively go after each of you who has worked at any point of time in the past without a current oath on file with the SOS. Fraudulently posing as a government agent also falls under the purview of the military. Legislators that Trump can lawfully prosecute include:

Bradford, Steven: Oaths of Office for Senate for 2017 – 2018 and 2021 – 2022 and Assembly for 2009 – 2010, 2011 – 2012 and 2013 – 2014. No oaths for 2019 – 2020 or 2022 – 2024; no bond/insurance on file.

<u>Caballero</u>, Anna: <u>Oath</u> of Office for 2023 – 2024 for her current job of State Senator. Was an <u>assemblyman</u> from 2006 – 2010 and from 2016 – 2018. She did not take an oath for either assembly term. No Insurance

<u>Durazo</u>, Maria Elena: <u>Oaths</u> of Office for 2019 – 2020 and 2023 – 2024, but no oath for 2021 – 2022. Also <u>No Insurance</u>

Grove, Shannon: Oaths of Office for Senate 2015 - 2016, 2019 - 2020, 2023 - 2024 and Assembly for 2011 - 2012 and 2013 - 2014. No oaths for 2015 - 2016 (Assembly) or 2017 - 2018 or 2021 - 2022 (Senate); no bond/insurance.

Laird, John: No oath for 2023- 2024; no bond. Oaths from 2003 – 2004, 2005 – 2006, and 2007 – 2008.

Rubio, Susan: Oath of office for 2023 - 2024 and 2019 - 2020. No oath for 2021 - 2022; no

insurance/bond.

Skinner, Nancy: No oath for 2023 – 2024 nor 2019 – 2020; no bond on file; Oaths of Office for Senate for 2017 – 2018 and 2021 – 22 and Assembly for 2009 – 2014.

Talamantes Eggman, Susan: Oaths of Office for Senate for 2021 – 2022 and Assembly for 2015 – 2016, 2017 – 2018 and 2019 – 2020. No oath for 2013 – 2014 or 2023 – 2024; no insurance/bond

Wiener, Scott: Only Oath of Office expired in 2018; no insurance/bond. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

And of course, Senate Staffers can be prosecuted, too.

It is unconscionable that every one of you at the State Senate is each working unlawfully without a surety bond, that the majority of you are working unlawfully without a current oath, and that each of you are knowingly and willfully violating state and federal laws.

Meanwhile, here is a reminder that, in addition to Wiener, the following legislators are also working unlawfully without current oaths. All of their legislative work needs to be voided, along with Wiener's:

Bradford, Steven: Oaths of Office for Senate for 2017 - 2018 and 2021 - 2022 and Assembly for 2009 - 2010, 2011 - 2012 and 2013 - 2014. No oaths for 2019 - 2020 or 2022 - 2024; no bond/insurance on file.

Laird, John: No oath for 2023- 2024; no bond. Oaths of Office for Senate 2021 – 2022 and Assembly from 2003 – 2004, 2005 – 2006, and 2007 – 2008.

Skinner, Nancy: No oath for 2023 - 2024 nor 2019 - 2020; no bond on file; Oaths of Office for Senate for 2017 - 2018 and 2021 - 22 and Assembly for 2009 - 2014.

Talamantes Eggman, Susan: Oaths of Office for Senate for 2021 – 2022 and Assembly for 2015 – 2016, 2017 – 2018 and 2019 – 2020. No oath for 2013 – 2014 or 2023 – 2024; no insurance/bond

Also a reminder that not one single senate staffer that I have checked has a current, properly executed oath on file with the SOS.

And finally, not one single person that I've checked who is employed by the state senate in any capacity has a surety bond. I believe that the entire state senate is currently illegitimate due to violating the bond laws set forth in codified in <u>California Government Code Section 1450 – 1463</u>.

My army is going to continue to grow until the State Senate finally complies with federal and state laws. The days of the state senate arrogantly proclaiming "rules for thee but not for me" are over.
