

Hello State Senate:

In the last email, I provided a list of legislators who I have caught working unlawfully without oaths at various points in time, including Senators Durazo and Caballero (those of you recently added to this list, the referenced email is below in the thread). Per 5 U.S. Code § 3331, every elected or appointed government official must sign an Oath of Office.

Below in this email, I provide a list of staffers who I have caught working unlawfully without oaths and bonds. Per 5 U.S.C. 3333: "...an individual who accepts office or employment in the government of the United States...shall execute an affidavit within 60 days after accepting the office or employment.

Anyone who is working unlawfully without said executed oath is considered to be a foreign agent posing as a government agent and subject to prosecution under US Criminal Code Title 18 U.S.C. § 912. Posing as a government agent is fraud, and there is no statute of limitation on fraud.

Some of the legislators that I have checked have managed to keep their oaths current through their government service. However, of the staffers that I have checked, ZERO have consistently stayed in compliance with the oath requirements set forth in California Government Code Sections 1027, 1360, 1362-1369, 18150 -18158, and Section 3 of Article XX of the Constitution of California.

Please keep in mind that Ms. Braverman, Ms. Cervinka, Ms. Contreras and Mr. Nam have never denied these facts to be true. failure to deny constitutes admission: Any material allegation in the complaint that is not effectively denied is deemed admitted. [CCP § 431.20(a); see Hennefer v. Butcher (1986) 182 CA3d 492, 504, 227 CR 318, 325].

I hope that each of you understands that YOU are responsible for yourselves. It is up to you to make sure that you have a current oath and bond filed with the Secretary of State's office. While Ms. Braverman, Ms. Cervinka, Ms. Contreras and Mr. Nam have criminally conspired together to evade complying with the federal and state oath and bond laws, their failure to perform does not exonerate you from the consequences of your failure to ensure that you are compliant with the laws. As the new session starts. I urge each of you to ensure you are compliant.

"We the people" will no longer tolerate our government employees failing to comply with the laws. The days of "rules for thee but not for me" are over.

Andrews, Michelle: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Barnet, Alex: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Brown, Samantha: Oath of Office was to \$TATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Brown's signature was redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed she still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

Chavez, Zandra: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Contreras, Erika: (I don't think any of the people listed is this Erika Contreras as none of the job titles match): Oaths of Office for 2019 – 2020 and 2023 – 2024, but no oath for 2021 – 2022. Also no Insurance.

Case, Doug: The <u>Senate Committee</u> stated they have no oath on file for him. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

Choe, Stella: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Davis, Grace: Oath of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Davis's and the witness signatures were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an

oain or procured a bond.

Duncan, John: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Duran, Antoinette: <u>Oath</u> of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Duran wrote her name in all-capital letters; Ms. Duran's and the witness signatures were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

Eisberg, Ryan: (there is <u>no public record</u> of earnings) No oath provided for his current job. The <u>Oath</u> of Office provided was for a different job that expired in 2002; Mr. Eisberg wrote his name in all-capital letters; Mr. Eisberg's and the witness signatures were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oathor procured a bond

Esparza, Anna: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Favorini-Csorba, Anton: Oath of Office was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Mr. Favorini-Csorba's, and the witness signatures were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Fontus, Stella: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Fritz, Niesha: Oath of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Fritz's and the witness signatures were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed she still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Gonzalez-Parra, Rubie: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Griffiths, Diane: (there is <u>no public record</u> of earnings for this job) No oath provided for her current job as General Counsel and Deputy Chief of Staff to Senator Atkins. Both <u>Oath</u>s of Office provided by the Senate Committee were for a different job that expired in 2012; both oaths were to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Griffith's and the witness signatures were redacted on both documents. The SOS confirmed that Ms. Griffith does not have an oath for her current job, but the SOS did provide an <u>Oath</u> of Office for an Advisory Committee that Ms. Griffiths sat on (which is already expired). That oath was taken to the STATE OF CALIFORNIA. <u>Ms. Griffith is an attorney</u>, and attorneys understand the importance of oaths. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed she still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Grinnell, Colin: (there is <u>no public record</u> of earnings) No oath provided for his current job. The <u>Oath</u> of Office provided was for a different job that expired in 2008; Mr. Grinnell wrote his name in all-capital letters; Mr. Grinnell's signature and the witness signature were both reducted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS

confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

Hardeman, Nick: (there is <u>no public record</u> of earnings for this job) No oath provided for his current job. The <u>Oath</u> of Office provided was for a different job that expired in 2006; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Mr. Hardeman's signature and the witness signature were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed <u>he still hasn't signed an oath</u> or procured a bond

Henderson, Vanessa: (there is <u>no public record</u> of earnings): <u>Unexecuted Oath</u> of Office (redacted to hide her signature, but they didn't redact that it was not witnessed. Also, she never stated the job that she was taking the oath for.) Oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed she still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

Ison, Pamela: (the income on public record is from before she went to work for Atkins. No income information under Atkins has been publicly disclosed). Unexecuted Oath of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Ison wrote her name in all-capital letters; Ms. Ison's signature was redacted; the notary never signed the document as a witness. (Update: Ms. Ison has apparently left the State Senate altogether).

Jordan, Stephanie: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Kennedy, Mary: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Loftin, Sarah: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Mebust, Erik: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Mohtashemi, Raayan: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Nam, John (I don't think any of the people listed is this John Nam as none of the job titles match): Oath of Office was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Mr. Nam's signature and the witness signature were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Persons, Jack: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Peterson, Jonathan: (I don't think any of the people listed is this Jonathan Peterson as none of the job titles match) Oath of Office was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Mr. Peterson's signature and the witness signature were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Pfefferkorn, Krista: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Reed, Cole: Oath of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Mr. Reed's signature was redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Rincon, Omar: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Rodriguez, Kimberly: No oath provided for her current job. The <u>Oath</u> of Office provided was for a different job that expired in 2018; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Rodriguez's signature and the witness signature were both redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed she still hasn't signed an <u>oath</u> or procured a bond

Severiano (Seve), Christian: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Sparks, Jeff: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024

Suseberry, Tylisa: Oath of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Ms. Suseberry's signature was redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed she still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond

Vallejo, Christopher: Oath of Office expired at the end of Atkins term in 2022; oath was to STATE OF CALIFORNIA; Mr. Vallejo's signature was redacted. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed he still hasn't signed an oath or procured a bond.

<u>Weisz</u>, Jason: <u>No Oath</u> was filed with the SOS for his job with Toni Atkins, though he did file an <u>Oath</u> for his side gig at the <u>Pharmacy Board</u>. The income listed on public records is only for the pharmacy board job; there is no public record of income for his assembly and Senate jobs. The Senate Committee did provide an expired <u>Oath</u> of Office that had been improperly redacted to hide signatures. I believe the purpose of the redaction was to hide that the Oath was not executed, and thus the reason it was never filed with the SOS. Mr. Weisz has <u>no insurance</u>. On September 18, 2024, the SOS confirmed <u>he still hasn't signed an oath</u> or procured a bond

Yeung, Elisa Rae: No oath or bond filed with SOS as of Sept 2024
