

Hello State Senate:

This is another reminder that "we the people" — your employers — will no longer tolerate State Senate employees brazenly violating federal and state laws by failing to keep oaths compliant with federal and state laws and by failing to procure surety bonds.

As I documented in the <u>Notice of Legal Violations</u>, the <u>Writ of Quo Warranto</u> and the <u>Certificate of Default</u> (<u>part 1</u>, <u>part 2</u>), I have been asking Wiener to sign a current oath since January of this year. Wiener has failed to do so, yet continued to work as a legislator while knowing full well that he was working unlawfully.

It is no surprise that Mr. Wiener has made the choice to risk prison rather than promise to uphold the constitutions. After all, Mr. Wiener aggressively pushes legislation that protects perpetrators and leaves victims more vulnerable, such as decriminalizing purchasing an infant prostitute as long as the "John" is 17 or younger (alterations made to SB-1414 by the Public Safety Committee). Child prostitution is a violation of the 13th amendment no matter what age the "John" may be, so in this case, Wiener was intentionally creating a law that violated the constitution.

I have also documented that Wiener's entire staff have conspired together to aid Wiener to commit this felony, and that multiple staff members also tried to cover up his crimes via fraud. Wiener's staff have made it clear that they believe that that laws don't apply to Wiener — or to

themselves, as *prima tascia* indicates that the majority of Wiener's staff are also working unlawfully without current, proper oaths or bonds.

I have likewise documented that the vast majority of Senator Atkins staff have working unlawfully without current, fully compliant oaths, as is some of the *pro tempore* staff. The 20 people named in the Notice of Legal Violations, the Writ of Quo Warranto and the Certificate of Default (part 1, part 2) have each known for over a year that they were working unlawfully, yet all of them failed to sign current oaths. It is disconcerting that all of these people made the choice to risk three-years in prison rather than simply sign a piece of paper promising to uphold the constitution. I can think of no reason to refuse to sign an oath that isn't nefarious.

I have documented that John Nam, Erika Contreras, Sheila Braverman, and Lynn Cervinka have conspired together to knowingly allow all of these people to continue to work unlawfully. I've documented that John Nam himself is working unlawfully with an expired oath and that Erika Contreras also has let her oath lapse over periods of service. Ms. Cervinka and Ms. Braverman have failed to provide oaths — I believe it is because they don't have current oaths, either.

The oversight staff, including Eleni Kounalakis, former *pro tempore* Toni Atkins, current *pro tempore* Mike McGuide and the Senate Rules Committee members and staff have also conspired together to allow Wiener and the others to perpetrate these crimes.

Furthermore, I have recently documented that Steven Bradford, Anna Caballero, Maria Elena Durazo, Shannon Grove, John Laird, Susan Rubio, Nancy Skinner and Susan Talamantes Eggman have each had lapses in oaths while serving in office. All of the legislative work done by each of them during each of their lapses must also be voided (see the email below in this thread dated November 12, which has links to the oaths which were filed with the Secretary of State — and notes which oaths were missing).

It is no surprise to me that Mr. Bradford and Ms. Skinner don't have current oaths, as they conspired with Wiener to violate the 13th amendment by altering SB-1414 to decriminalize baby rape in some situations.

Every day, people sign my petition to void Wiener's legislative work since Wiener had no legal standing. Our army will continue to grow in number because "we the people" have had enough of our employees telling us to "F-off" when we ask them to follow the laws. "We the people" will no longer tolerate the arrogance of the State Senate telling us constituents that "Laws are for thee, but not for me." It is unconscionable that the very people who make laws refuse to follow them.

It is time for the State Senate to rectify these crimes they have committed against the constituents by voiding all of Wiener's legislative work since January 2019, along with the legislative work done by Bradford, Caballero, Durazo, Grove, Laird, Rubio, Skinner and Talamantes Eggman for the periods where there was a lapse in their oaths.

Furthermore, "we the people" will no longer toler ate the State Senate refusing to comply with the surety bond laws. Bonds are protections for "we the people" that our government agents won't harm us. The fact that the State Senate doesn't utilize bonds indicaties that the State Senate's intent is to harm us constituents.

While failing to procure bonds doesn't have the same severe penalty of prison that failing to sign a proper oath does, "we the people" can -- and will — remove any government agent who does not have a bond. We'll be policing bonds in the new legislative session.

Hello State Senate:

In the last email, I provided a list of legislators who I have caught working unlawfully without oaths at various points in time, including Senators Durazo and Caballero (those of you recently added to this list, the referenced email is below in the thread). Per 5 U.S. Code § 3331, every elected or appointed government official must sign an Oath of Office.

Below in this email, I provide a list of staffers who I have caught working unlawfully without oaths and bonds. Per 5 U.S.C. 3333: "...an individual who accepts office or employment in the government of the United States...shall execute an affidavit within 60 days after accepting the office or employment.

Anyone who is working unlawfully without said executed oath is considered to be a foreign agent posing as a government agent and subject to prosecution under US Criminal Code Title 18 U.S.C. § 912. Posing as a government agent is fraud, and there is no statute of limitation on fraud.

Some of the legislators that I have checked have managed to keep their oaths current through their government service. However, of the staffers that I have checked, ZERO have consistently stayed in compliance with the oath requirements set forth in California Government Code Sections 1027, 1360, 1362-1369, 18150 -18158, and Section 3 of Article XX of the Constitution of California.

Please keep in mind that Ms. Braverman, Ms. Cervinka, Ms. Contreras and Mr. Nam have never denied these facts to be true. failure to deny constitutes admission: Any material allegation in the complaint that is not effectively denied is deemed admitted. [CCP § 431.20(a); see Hennefer v. Butcher (1986) 182 CA3d 492, 504, 227 CR 318, 325].

I hope that each of you understands that YOU are responsible for yourselves. It is up to you to make sure that you have a current oath and bond filed with the Secretary of State's office. While Ms. Braverman, Ms. Cervinka, Ms. Contreras and Mr. Nam have criminally conspired together to evade complying with the federal and state oath and bond laws, their failure to perform does not exonerate you from the consequences of your failure to ensure that you are compliant with the laws. As the new session starts. I urge each of you to ensure you are compliant.

"We the people" will no longer tolerate our government employees failing to comply with the laws. The days of "rules for thee but not for me" are over.
