Hello State Senate:

Just a reminder that the SOS has stated that NONE OF THE STATE SENTORS OR STAFFERS that I checked has a current oath on file, nor does Eleni Kounalakis.

I have yet to get a current oath from the state senate for anyone. The oaths were due on December 17, 2024 and are now 3 months and 10 days past due. Only yesterday, Mr. Nam told me he will not give me any information as to whether or not those oaths will ever be provided, let alone a date for providing them. Mr. Nam made it abundantly clear that he doesn't care that failure to provide a date is a violation of the LORA laws.

None of you have sent me your oath yourselves, despite the fact that failure to provide oaths is a violation of the Brown Act. It is YOUR OWN responsibility to prove that you are lawfully employed.

At this point, it appears that you have all unilaterally conspired together to evade the oath and bond laws. We the people will not tolerate this. Please, if these oaths exist, provide them immediately. If you do not provide these oaths, the constituents will have no choice but to implement accountability measures.
