Dear Christine Grab,

Thank you for applying through Covered California for your health insurance needs. Covered California is a voter registration agency and we are required to offer every person who submitted an application for health insurance the opportunity to register to vote. This notice provides you the opportunity to register to vote.

Applying to register or declining to register to vote will *not* affect your health benefits or the amount of assistance available from Covered California, Medi-Cal, or any other California agency. Covered California did not check voter registration records before sending this mailing, so if you are already registered to vote where you live now you do not need to re-register.

If you are eligible to vote but you are not registered to vote where you live now, you can apply to register today. You can apply by filling out the enclosed postage pre-paid voter registration card. You or any eligible household member can fill out the enclosed voter registration application. You and any eligible household members can also apply to register to vote:

1. By completing the form online at RegisterToVote.ca.gov; or
2. By calling (800) 345-VOTE (8683) to request more voter registration cards; or
3. By visiting your county elections office.

You must be a U.S. citizen and at least 18 years old on Election Day to register to vote. You should review the voter registration application for other eligibility requirements. If you would like help filling out the voter registration application form, please call the Secretary of State at (800) 345-VOTE (8683). The choice to seek help or assistance with voter registration is yours. You may fill out the form in private.

You may file a complaint with the Secretary of State if you believe that someone has interfered with any of your following rights: your right to register to vote; your right to decline to register to vote; your right to privacy in deciding whether to register or in applying to register to vote; or your right to choose your own political party preference or other political preference.
